5 Roles of the Blood of Jesus Christ in Purpose.



1] The Blood of Jesus Christ Cleanses us.

2] The Blood of Jesus Christ Completes us.

3] The Blood of Jesus Christ Loose (releases) us.

4] Through the Blood of Jesus Christ we overcome.

5] The Blood of Jesus Christ destroys the power of the devil and the power of death.



The Blood of Jesus Christ Cleanses us.

Hebrews 9:14 (NIV)

How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!

1 John 1:7 (NKJV)

“But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and *the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin*” (italics mine).



The Blood of Jesus Christ Completes us.

Heb 13:20-21 (NKJV)

Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, *through the blood of the everlasting covenant*, make you *complete* in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* glory forever and ever. Amen.



The Blood of Jesus Christ Loose (releases) us.

Rev 1:5 (ASV)

“...and from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loveth us, and *loosed us from our sins by his blood...*”



Through the Blood of Jesus Christ, we overcome.

Rev 12:11 (NKJV)

“And they *overcame* him by *the blood of the Lamb* and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death”.



The Blood of Jesus Christ *destroys* the power of the devil and the power of the death.

Heb 2:14-15 (NLT)

“Because God’s children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a human being could he die, and only by dying could *he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death*. Only in this way could he set free all who have lived their lives as slaves to the fear of dying”.

1 Corinthians 11:23-26 [NIV]

23 For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread,

24 and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.”

25 In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.”

26 For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.
