



Altar of Reconciliation



"In that day there will be an altar to the LORD in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar to the LORD at its border"
Isaiah 19:19 NKJV

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About

Then He said to Abram: 'Know certainly that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, and will serve them, and they will afflict them four hundred years. And also the nation whom they serve I will judge; afterward, they shall come out with great possessions. Genesis 15:13-14 NKJV

On August 25, 1619, a set of slaves from Africa arrived the shores of Point Comfort (today's Fort Monroe) in Hampton, Virginia in the USA. This was not the first time that slaves from Africa arrived the Americas or other parts of the globe, but it is the starting point for this journey of reconciliation especially because August 25, 2019, marks its 400th anniversary.

The first mention of four hundred years in the Bible is when God told Abram that bondage or slavery shall be the fate of his descendants for that length of time. God also told Abram that He will judge the nation whom they, Abram's descendants, serve.

In Genesis 12:2-3 NKJV we see God's promise to Abram as follows: "I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you, all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

Abraham's descendants were treated as slaves in Egypt for 400 years. We believe that the guilt of Egypt is the guilt of Africa and that it is God's judgement of this guilt that's the root cause of the enslavement of Africa and Africans.

Our God is right and just in permitting Africans to go into slavery, and it is our duty to know the number of years that the curse will last.

"The sons of Ham were Cush, Mizraim, Put, and Canaan" Genesis 10:6 NKJV. These represent Ethiopia, Egypt, Libya, and first settlers in Israel. Africa (Cush) is one of the sons of Ham, who himself was the least important of Noah's sons.

Genesis 9:22-25 NKJV reads, "And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brothers outside. But Shem and Japheth took a garment, laid it on both their shoulders, and went backward and covered the nakedness of their father.

Their faces were turned away, and they did not see their father's nakedness. So Noah awoke from his wine, and knew what his younger son had done to him. Then he said, 'Cursed be Canaan; a servant of servants he shall be to his brethren' 'Noah's curse reiterates the curse of those who curse Israel.

Our Christian belief is that God is always right and just in His judgment. Israel went into slavery in Africa until Moses came along.

Africans have been in slavery for a much longer time, and we believe that the time has come for the new Moses of Africa. In 1 Chronicles 12:32a NKJV we find that "of the sons of Issachar who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do..."

We learn from this that understanding the times of the LORD is very crucial for changing the course of a people.

Daniel 9:2 NKJV "in the first year of his reign I, Daniel, understood by the books the number of the years specified by the word of the LORD through Jeremiah the prophet, that He would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem." Daniel had a proper understanding of the times, to know what his people ought to do, by reading Jeremiah.

We strongly believe that the LORD led us to read Isaiah 19 in view of the 400th anniversary of the bondage of Africa and Africans.

Mandate

The Outgivers Ministries shall raise an Altar of Reconciliation in the heart of Africa that shall focus on making an impact on God's children in every street corner, alley, inner-city, neighborhood, village, town, church, synagogue, mosque, temple, club, the marketplace, public and private institution, etc.

Goal #1

Engage true worshippers to reconcile the next generation of Africans with their African roots so that Africans, anywhere in the world, may have hope again in Africa.

Goal #2

Engage the African Union to reconcile Africa with her children who were sold to slavery to the Americas.

Goal #3

Reconcile Africa with Assyria. This reconciliation shall be championed by a select team of missionaries and youths from the Altar of Reconciliation, in the heart of Africa, to Northern Iraq, Southeastern Turkey, Northwestern Iran, and Northeastern Syria.

Goal #4

The reconciliation of Africa and Assyria as true worshippers shall pave the way for the reconciliation of Africa and Israel. In Isaiah 19:24-25 we read, "In that day Israel will be one of three with Egypt and Assyria – a blessing in the midst of the land, whom the LORD of hosts shall bless saying, 'Blessed is Egypt My people, and Assyria the work of My hands, and Israel My inheritance.'"

Strategy



- To recruit, train, and send missionaries, and youths with a penchant for true worship to every square foot of the continent. The missionaries shall each have a maximum of twelve families to minister to, and shall purposefully identify and train three people to replicate his or her example in the community.
- Christians shall be trained to grow in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man as in Luke 2:52 NKJV (4-Dimensional).
- To establish brotherly relationships on both sides of the Red Sea and the Mediterranean Sea which shall culminate in the fulfillment of what's written in Isaiah 19:23 NKJV which reads, "In that day there will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian will come into Egypt and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians will serve with the Assyrians."

Africans are descendants of Ham (Genesis 10:6 NKJV - "The sons of Ham were Cush, Mizraim, Put, and Canaan.") These represent Ethiopia, Egypt, Libya, and first settlers in Israel.)

In Genesis 10:8-12 NKJV we find, "Cush begot Nimrod, and he began to be a mighty one on the earth.

He was a mighty hunter before the LORD; therefore it is said, 'Like Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD.' And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, Erech, Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar.

"From that land, he went to Assyria and built Nineveh, Rehoboth Ir, Calah, and Resen between Nineveh and Calah (that is the principal city).



The unity of Africa, Assyria, and Israel on the Altar of Reconciliation shall be pleasing to the God Who Seeks true worshippers (John 4:23), and He will release a new 'Samaritan Woman' experience that will cause His children to be reconciled back to Him.

Like a cord of three strands (Ecclesiastes 4:12), Africa, Assyria, and Israel shall be woven together as true worshippers to pave the way for peace in Jerusalem, respect of every life, and break the chain of slavery over Africa and Africans.
