Ephesians 1:1-13 (NLT)



Identifying the benefits of God while we praise

- Psalm 103:1-5 (NIV)
- ¹Praise the LORD, my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name.
- ² Praise the LORD, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—
- ³ who <u>forgives all your sins</u> and <u>heals all your diseases</u>,
- 4 who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion,
- ⁵ who <u>satisfies your desires with good things</u> so that <u>your youth is renewed like the eagle's.</u>



Guiding tips to Offering Effective Prayer of Praise to God

- Prayer of Praise should be prayed to God, in the name of Jesus.
- Prayer of Praise should not be indirect and generalized.

For Example:

- "I praise HIM for all He has done." Rather...
- "Father, I praise you, for giving me long life."
- Prayer of Praise is most effective when we set aside time to carefully identify what we are praising Him for.
- Saying "I praise You Father" or "I will praise You" as a way of offering praise, is not necessarily praise. It is a statement of intent concerning what you plan to do.
- Prayer of Praise typically contains words of acknowledgment, words of appreciation, words of thanksgiving, words of admiration.
- Prayer of Praise should be done joyfully.

- Will help the believer appreciate, once more their identity in Christ.
- Will help the believer express authentic praise to God as they understand their inheritances in Christ.
- Will help the believer appreciate how God thinks about them.



Praise God for Spiritual Blessings

- 3 All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ.
- ⁴ Even before he made the world, God <u>loved us</u> and <u>chose us</u> in Christ to be <u>holy</u> and <u>without fault in his eyes.</u>
- ⁵God decided in advance to <u>adopt us</u> into his own family by <u>bringing us to himself through</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u>. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure.
- 6 So we praise God for the glorious grace he has poured out on us who belong to his dear Son.
- ⁷ He is so rich in kindness and grace that he <u>purchased our freedom</u> with the blood of his Son and <u>forgave our sins.</u>
- 8 He has showered <u>his kindness on us</u>, along with <u>all wisdom and understanding</u>.

Identifying Praise Points

- I have been blessed with all spiritual blessing in the heavenly realm. vs 3
- I am united with Christ. vs 3
- Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes. vs 4
- God decided in advance to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure. vs 5



Identifying Praise Points

- So we praise God for the glorious grace he has poured out on us who belong to his dear Son. vs 6
- He is so rich in kindness and grace that he purchased our freedom with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins. vs 7

 vs 8

 Chapter 6:10 = Teaches how to stand in our position in Christ, against the wiles of the enemy.
