The Body of Jesus Christ

1 Corinthians 11:23-24 (NKJV)

For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the *same* night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”

- Jesus’ body is the bread of life (John 6:35 ... ³⁵ Then Jesus declared, “**I am the bread of life...**”).
- Upon the whole body of Jesus was placed all our “misses” ...

Our missteps, miscalculations, misjudgments, mistakes, miscarriages, mismanagements, misconceptions, misperceptions, misunderstandings, misleading, misdiagnoses, misapplications, misinterpretations, misdealing, etc.

- Every indication of lack of wholeness on our part was placed upon the whole body of Jesus Christ and as a result, his body experienced brokenness.

Spiritual Exchange

1 Corinthians 11:23-24 (NKJV)

For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the *same* night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”

- Our brokenness was exchanged for the wholeness of Jesus.

Partake

1 Corinthians 11:23-24 (NKJV)

For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the *same* night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”

- Therefore, today, we partake unto wholeness, discerning that the “body” of Jesus was broken so ours can be made whole.

The Blood of Jesus Christ

Ephesians 2:13 (NLT)

But now you have been united with Christ Jesus.

Once you were far away from God, but now you have been brought near to him through the blood of Christ.

Sin separates, that is why...

1 John 2:2 (NKJV)

And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

Spiritual Exchange

Ephesians 2:13 (NLT)

But now you have been united with Christ Jesus.

Once you were far away from God, but now you have been brought near to him through the blood of Christ.

- God cannot go near sin. Sin therefore separates us from God.
- The blood of Jesus bridged the gap that sin created.
- The blood of Jesus re-established our relationship with God.
- When God sees us, He sees the blood first, advocating for mankind.
- The blood speaks of a new report and testimony about us because of Jesus' sacrifice.

Partake

Ephesians 2:13 (NLT)

But now you have been united with Christ Jesus.

Once you were far away from God, but now you have been brought near to him through the blood of Christ.

- Therefore, we partake unto the understanding that our relationship with God has been restored through the blood of Jesus.
- We partake unto the understanding that we are united with Christ Jesus and because of that we are closer to God than away from Him.
- So, we can communicate with God as children in relationship. Not distant from their Father.
