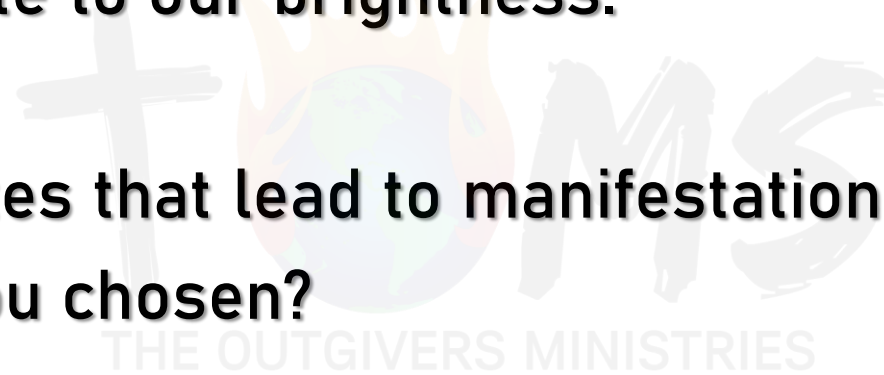

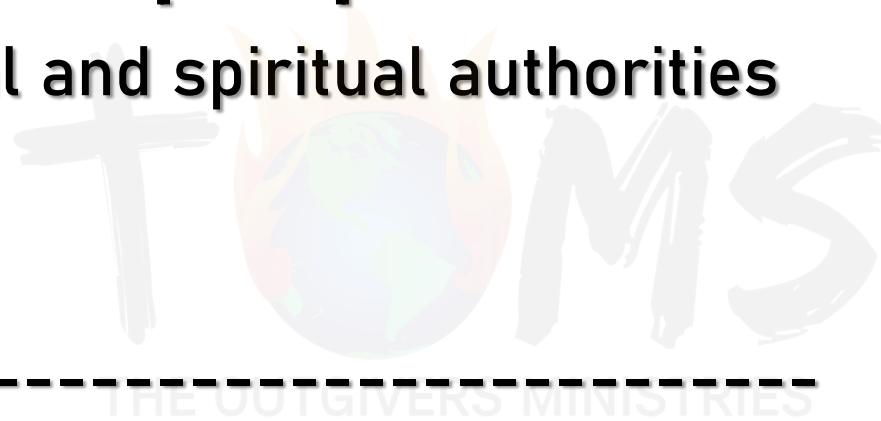
⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;

THE OUTGIVERS MINISTRIES

¹ In the days when the judges ruled, there was a famine in the land. So, a man from Bethlehem in Judah, together with his wife and two sons, went to live for a while in the country of Moab.

² The man's name was Elimelek, his wife's name was Naomi, and the names of his two sons were Mahlon and Kilion. They were Ephrathites from Bethlehem, Judah. And they went to Moab and lived there.

³ Now Elimelek, Naomi's husband, died, and she was left with her two sons.

⁴ They married Moabite women, one named Orpah and the other Ruth. After they had lived there about ten years,

⁵ both Mahlon and Kilion also died, and Naomi was left without her two sons and her husband.

6 When Naomi heard in Moab that the LORD had come to the aid of his people by providing food for them, she and her daughters-in-law prepared to return home from there.

7 With her two daughters-in-law she left the place where she had been living and set out on the road that would take them back to the land of Judah.

8 Then Naomi said to her two daughters-in-law, “Go back, each of you, to your mother’s home. May the LORD show you kindness, as you have shown kindness to your dead husbands and to me.

9 May the LORD grant that each of you will find rest in the home of another husband.” Then she kissed them goodbye, and they wept aloud

10 and said to her, “We will go back with you to your people.”

¹¹ But Naomi said, “Return home, my daughters. Why would you come with me? Am I going to have any more sons, who could become your husbands?”

¹² Return home, my daughters; I am too old to have another husband. Even if I thought there was still hope for me—even if I had a husband tonight and then gave birth to sons—

¹³ would you wait until they grew up? Would you remain unmarried for them? No, my daughters. It is more bitter for me than for you, because the LORD’s hand has turned against me!”

¹⁴ At this they wept aloud again. Then Orpah kissed her mother-in-law goodbye, but Ruth clung to her.

¹⁵ “Look,” said Naomi, “your sister-in-law is going back to her people and her gods. Go back with her.

16 But Ruth replied, “Don’t urge me to leave you or to turn back from you. Where you go, I will go, and where you stay, I will stay. Your people will be my people and your God my God.

17 Where you die, I will die, and there I will be buried. May the LORD deal with me, be it ever so severely, if even death separates you and me.”

18 When Naomi realized that Ruth was determined to go with her, she stopped urging her.

THE OUTGIVERS MINISTRIES

People	Journey	Destination
Elimelech / Naomi/ Mahlon / Kilion	Judah to Moab (vs 1-5)	Arrived; everyone died but Naomi.
Naomi / Orpah / Ruth	Set out on the path back to Judah (vs 6 & 7)	Orpah changed her mind and returned to Moab.
Naomi / Ruth	Finally set out for Judah	Both arrive Judah

Pathway to the Brightness of Our Manifestation

- Where you go, I will go – Place (Location)
- Where you stay, I will stay – Space (Environment)
- Your people will be my people – Association
- Your God my God – Believe system
- Where you die, I will die – Sacrifice
- There I will be buried – Commitment

Where you go, I will go – Place (Location) – Geographically

- There is a location destined for our manifestation.
- Naomi and Ruth were destined to manifest in Bethlehem not in Moab.



- Adam was destined to manifest in Eden.

¹⁵ The LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it.

¹⁶ And the LORD God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden;



- Elijah was destined to experience manifestations of provisions by the Brook Cherith.

1 Kings 17:2-4 (NKJV)

² Then the word of the LORD came to him, saying,

³ "Get away from here and turn eastward, and hide by the Brook Cherith, which flows into the Jordan.

⁴ And it will be *that* you shall drink from the brook, and I have commanded the ravens to feed you there."

Where you stay, I will stay – Space (Environment)

- There is a specific environment designed for our manifestation.

¹⁸ My people will live in peaceful dwelling places, in secure homes, in undisturbed places of rest.



Your people will be my people - Association

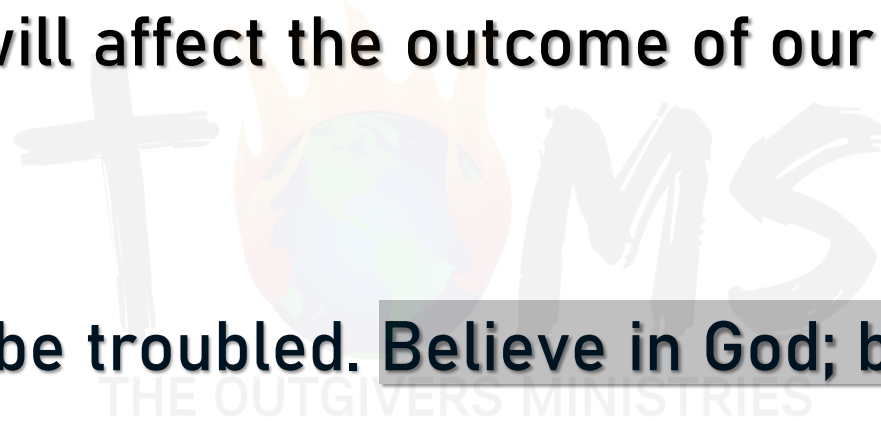
17 Therefore, "Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you."

Living Sacrifice

Romans 12:1-2 (NKJV)

¹ I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service.

² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

- Living Sacrifice is a lifestyle.
- It is a journey not a destination.
